With regard to the subject and reference cited above, the point wise reply w.r.t your RTI are as under:


On what grounds is it decided that particular leopards, tigers, lions or other big cat should be captured.	When they become dangerous to human life/ repeatedly entering human habitation.		
What is the exact procedure of setting up a cage them.	By placing appropriate cages with suitable bait in separate cage is placed near frequently reported/ sighted locations for several days under periodic inspection by wildlife team by taking proper care of bait.


